Then I place the center of the Protractor on C, and because the degrees of the angle at C are less than 180, I lay the beginning of the degrees of the Protractor towards B, the last station, and the diameter on BC. Then close to the edge of the Protractor, with my Protracting Pin, I make a mark against 1430 45 ; the quantity of the angle at C, and to it draw an obscure right line from C, representing the line from C to D. Then turn the Protractor about, its center still coinciding with C, because the bearing is more than 180, the beginning of the degrees towards S, and the diameter parallel to the meridians; and then if you have work-ed truly, the line CD before drawn,...
